Remarks	Division of Physician Scientist: (1) The minimum requirement for the Seminar course has been adjusted to a total of 4 credits, which must be completed over 2 semesters. (2) Completed and passed courses in the Department of Medicine's Physician Scientist Research in Master Program (1) to (4) course(12 credits in total) may be counted towards graduation credits at the Institute. (3) Who have completed and passed the Physiology and Physiology Experiment courses in the Department of Medicine should apply for exemption during the freshman registration period. Upon approval, they may be exempted from the corresponding courses.
